EAMES, REV. THOMAS **died 1/14/1826 (85 YRS.)**

KENISTON, HANNAH **died. 4/15/1852 (74 YRS.)**

KENISTON, MOSES **died 1839, ae 68 (husband to Hannah)**

FULLER, OLIVER M. **died 4/13/1835, 15 MO. son of Samuel & Oliviah**

GILLIES, ELDORETTA **died 6/10/1856, 5 MO. 18 DAY (dau. Of W. H. A. Gillies)**

GILLIES, WM. B. **died. March 19, 1862, 51 yrs.**

GILLES, BARBARA A. **8/21/1836, 4yrs., 5 mo., dau. of S. R. Bickmore**

BICKMORE, RACHEL **died March 12, 1864, 85 yrs –(WRITTEN ON STONE-BELOW)**

SPRAGUE, HIRAM **died 6/20/1853 47 YRS.**

SPRAGUE, NOAH **died March 4, 1838, ae. 62 yrs., 9 mo.**

SPRAGUE, LUCY ANN **died March 4, 1826, ae. 49 yrs. (wife of Noah)**

STEVENS, MARTHA B. **died 10/23/1891ae 81 YRS. (WIFE OF Isaiah (formerly Brown))**

STEVENS, MARK, **died 12/21/79, 28 yrs. (son of Isaiah and Martha)**
